- ✓ No-Cost coverage for pregnant women
- ✓ No-Cost (MCHP) or Low-Cost (MCHP Premium) coverage for children - Low-Cost Coverage provided at a flat fee of \$48 or \$60 (depending on income) per month per family
- ✓ Services provided through private health plans participating in *HealthChoice*, Maryland's Medical Managed Care Program

#### Benefits For Children Include:

- Doctor Visits (well and sick care)
- Hospital Care
- Specialist Care and Related Therapies
- Lab Work and Tests
- Immunizations (shots)
- Prescription Medicines
- Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
- Dental and Vision Care

#### Benefits For Pregnant Women Include:

- Prenatal and Post-Partum Doctor Visits
- Hospital Delivery
- Doctors Visits not relating to Pregnancy
- Lab Work and Tests
- Prescription Medicines (including vitamins)
- Dental Preventive and Treatment Services
- Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services
- Family Planning Services after delivery
