

Did You Know....

If you had health coverage through Maryland's Medical Assistance or the Maryland Children's Health Program

You May Be Eligible For The FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM?

How does the program work?

A woman loses her pregnancy-related health plan coverage two months after delivery. She is automatically mailed a purple and white Medical Assistance card for the Family Planning Program (FPP). This covers services related to birth control only. *You will no longer be enrolled in a health plan.*

A woman eligible for the FPP receives benefits for five years unless she:

- Becomes eligible for another Medical Assistance Program
- Moves out of the State of Maryland
- No longer needs birth control because she has had a permanent sterilization (tubal ligation)
- Exceeds the qualifying family income level
- Fails to respond to written requests for income information

If your pregnancy related medical coverage has ended and you have not received a Family Planning Card two months after you deliver, please call 1-800-456-8900 to verify your eligibility for this program.



What services and benefits are included in the Family Planning Program?

- Annual pelvic exam
- Annual PAP test
- Screenings for STDs and HIV

- Birth Control Options
 - Birth control pills*
 - Depo-Provera shots*
 - Diaphragms*
 - Tubal ligation (tubes tied)*
- IUDs*
- Ortho Evra Patch*
- Spermicides*

What is NOT covered?

A woman in the Family Planning Program no longer has full medical coverage. If she has other medical, fertility, GYN problems, or needs abortion services, *the provider may charge for the services.*

If you become pregnant and need pregnancy-related benefits, call 1-800-456-8900 to determine if you are eligible for full Medical Assistance coverage.

If you have been diagnosed with a STD and have no other health care coverage, you may contact one of the health centers on the reverse side of this flyer for treatment on a sliding fee scale.

ASK YOUR OB/GYN PROVIDER IF THEY ACCEPT THE FAMILY PLANNING CARD OR CONTACT ONE OF THE HEALTH CENTERS ON THE BACK OF THIS FLYER

The Health Centers listed on the back can also provide other types of medical care.
