

Are you aging out of foster care soon?

You may be eligible for FREE health insurance, but you have to sign up!

If you were in foster care at age 18, you are eligible for FREE Medicaid health insurance. Medicaid will cover you until age 26. Sign up now to stay healthy!

What is Medicaid?

Medicaid is **health insurance** that will pay for your doctor's visits and protect you if you become sick or injured. Medicaid covers health conditions like diabetes, asthma, high blood pressure, and others.

Medicaid Covers

- Visits to the doctor
- Prescriptions and birth control
- Care for pregnant women and newborns
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Emergency room and hospital visits
- Surgery
- Physical therapy

How do you sign up for Medicaid?

Ask your **foster care caseworker** or call **MATCH** at **1-443-423-5929**. You can enroll for FREE Medicaid until age 26, regardless of your income, if:

- You received foster care services until you were 18 or older
- You are currently under 26

Health care coordination for all children in foster care with Baltimore City Department of Social Services You will NOT automatically be eligible for Medicaid if you:*

- Were legally adopted before age 18
- Had a legal guardian before age 18
- Were reunified with your parents before age 18
- Were not in foster care until your 18th birthday

*If any of these apply to you, you may still be eligible to enroll in Medicaid based on your income.
